

Notes on point gathering:  
Atlas of the City of Boston from actual surveys and official plans Boston  
proper and Back Bay

- Map 1
  - There are two 29's listed on Beacon St. the one closest to Bowdoin St. should be 27.
  - Province Ct. and Ordway Pl. – Numbers 4 and 3 closer to Ordway Pl. belong to it while the 20, 19, 18, 17 belong to Province Ct.
- Map 2
  - The number 41 listed on Mt. Vernon St. is actually part of Brimmer St.
  - On Joy St. both listings of number 10 do belong to Joy St.
  - On West Cedar St. 58 and 60 are repeated but only the 60 north of Revere St. is recorded as only the 58 south of Revere St. recorded.
  - The 28A on Phillips St. is out of numerical order for the street numbering and could belong to Anderson St. as there is a 28 Anderson St. listed not far away from the 28A.
- Map 3
  - At the corner of Eaton and North Russell St. numbers 23, 20, 22, 21 belong to Eaton St.
  - McLean Ct. has two number 8's listed on it and both have been documented as part of the Court.
- Map 4
  - On Court St. there are two 97's listed on the street and both were recorded.
  - On Salt Ln. in between numbers 1 and 5 there is a number that could not be identified.
  - The 86.5 listed on Union St. appears in the 1905 database along with an 86 which does not appear in this map.
  - Cusson Pl. had two numbers that were hard to understand but they have been listed as 1, 2, 3, 4, 5.
- Map 5
  - Lowell St. has two number 13s listed and both were documented.
  - On Milton St. 11 and 9 are out of numerical order but there is no reason to doubt that they do belong there.
- Map 6
  - On Beverly St. there is a gray line going through one of the numbers but it is number 41 Beverly St.
  - On Prince St. the ½ that is in between 110 and 108 belongs to 108 not 110, and the number was documented as 108.5.
  - The 175 which is closer to 183 should be 181, according the directories.
  - In Endicott Ct. the number the left of the 5 is a seven it is just out of numerical order.

- The 33 on Endicott St. also belongs where it is, it too is just out of numerical order.
- All of the numbers in Thacher Ct. have been documented as they appear.
- On Morton St. there are two 16 listed and both are documented as 16 because it is unclear what number one of them could be.
- Also on Morton St. there are two 5's listed on either side of a 3, both were documented.
- There are two 46's listed on Salem St. they have both been documented as 46 although one of them could be 42 as there was 42 Salem St. listed in the 1905 directory.
- Map 7
  - On Snowhill St. the number between 27 and 31 is a 29, there is one recorded in the 1885 directory.
- Map 8
  - In Fulton Pl. the 27 is out of order from the rest of the numbers, but it does belong to Fulton Pl.
  - On Moon St. the 10 in between 17 and 23 should be a 19, there is a 19 Moon St. in the 1905 directory.
  - On Hanover St. there are two 164's the one closer to the 150 could be a 154 according to the 1885 directory.
- Map 9
  - 50, 54, 58 belong to Liberty Sq.
  - The U.S. Customs House is on India St.
- Map 10
  - 43, 45, 53 belong to State St.
  - On Atlantic Ave. the 339 next to 397 is documented as a 399 because 339 does not belong there. 399 Atlantic Ave. was not found in the directories, but it is more likely 399.
  - On Devonshire St. 63 is listed twice, and was recorded twice.
  - On Devonshire St. there are two 202's listed. The one closest to 214, according to the 1905 directory should be 206.
- Map 18
  - Washington St. 108 according to the 1925 directory is 1083.
  - On Fayette St. the number between 48 and 52 appears to be crossed out or erased, and was not found in any of the directories.
  - The 436 closer to 432 was found as 434 in the 1925 directory.
  - Shawmut Ave. has two 165's at the intersection of Shawmut Ave. and Compton St. both have been recorded as 165.
