

Notes on point gathering:
Atlas of 1874

- Map A
 - North Centre St. has numbers listed 8, 7, and 14, although out of numerical order, there is no information to say they are out of place and have recorded in the order they appear.
 - The number between 63 and 65 on Eastern Ave. has not been recorded, as it is a misprint.
 - The 199 on Hanover St. directly above 197 has not been recorded as it is a misprint.
 - On Fulton Pl. the numbers on the right side of the street are, 22, 21, 19, 21, 23, 25, 27, and 29. It is unclear why there are even numbers on the odd side of the street, or why there is a duplicate 21. All have been recorded.
 - On Commercial St. by the block of buildings labeled Commercial Wharf Corporation, there are numbers 1 and 2 on the Commercial St. side, they belong to Commercial Whf.
- Map B
 - 458 Commercial St. on the map is a misprint and has been recorded at 548 Commercial St. which matches the surrounding numbers.
 - The number between 85 and 83 Charter St. has been given two points one with 85 and the other with 83.
 - There are some numbers off of Greenough Ln. that are unaccountable on any street.
 - The street intersecting with Webster Ave., Revere has an unknown roadway ending.
- Map F
 - Numbers 34 through 45 on Commerce street look like they are on State street, but they are not as this is not consistent with the numbering
- Map F

- Map G
 - What appear to be numbers 1 through 28 on Court street are actually on Tremont Row. This can be seen by looking at the corresponding plate of the 1898 atlas.
 - The street that is listed as Park street has duplicates of numbers 1 through 9. According to Map L, the section of street that appears to be Park street between Beacon and Mt. Vernon is actually part of Temple street, however, the numbers listed on this section of the street do not match up with Temple street either.
 - There are three occurrences, in a row, of 55 Tremont street. Only the middle address has been recorded.

- In between Devonshire and Washington streets and across from the Old State House, numbers 5 through 17 belong to State street, even though it is not listed on the plate.
- Numbers 6 through 9 around Bowdoin Square have no street or square to attach to. They appear to be on Cambridge street, but do not match up.
- Map H
 - Numbers 6 and 7 around Bowdoin Square have no street or square to attach to.
 - Numbers 34 through 40 that appear to be on North Market street actually belong to Faneuil Hall square.
 - Numbers 28, 30 and 31 around Dock square actually belong to Faneuil Hall square. Numbers 31 and 33 near Exchange street are part of Dock square.
 - Where Court street ends, numbers starting with 2 and going up belong to State street, even though it is not listed on the map.
- Map I
 - Otis street has a string of numbers listed 46, *44*, 48, *46*, 50, *48*, 52, *50*. Those in italics were omitted. It should read 46, 48, 50, 52.
- Map J
 - East St. Pl. has double numbering of 2, 3, 4, and 6, all have been recorded.
 - On South St. numbers 179 and 183 are mistaken written and should be 79 and 83.
 - High St. has two 21's listed, the 21 closer to 25 has been recorded as 23.
 - The 17 and 15 on High St. between 15 and 13 are not recorded, as they are misprints.
 - Map K
 - Purchase street has duplicate numbers. Numbers 101 through 147 do not fit in the sequencing of the numbers and do not exist in this place in other atlases. It is a misprint and none of the addresses have been recorded.
 - Purchase street has a number 9 just in front of numbers 101 and 103, it has been recorded as 99 Purchase street.
- Map L
 - This map has Pinckney St. written as Pickney St., Pinckney is the correct spelling.
 - 55 Joy St. on the evens side of the street should be a 54, as there is a 55 on the other side and this maintains numerical order.
 - Above Anderson Pl. there are 4 numbers on an unmarked alley. The alley is Anderson Ct. according to the 1875 directory.
- Map M
 - The roadway labeled Revere is Revere St.
 - The 6 next to the G in Gilson Ct. should be a 7, and has been recorded that way.
 - The 92 to the left of Brimmer St. on the unmark road is on Beaver Pl. according to the Mass_GIS street data.

- Lime St. has duplicate numberings of 3, 5, and 7 all have been recorded, as there is no evidence to disprove their existence as is.
- There is an extra 3 next to River St. Pl. it has been recorded as part of River St. Pl.
- Map P
 - On Kneeland St. there are two 132's listed. The one closer to 128 has been recorded as 130, which will maintain the numerical sequence and eliminate the duplicity
- Map Q
 - At the intersection of Tremont St. and Shawmut Ave. the numbers all belong to Tremont St., based on information from the book Boston Streets: Also its Avenues, Courts, Places, etc.
- Map R
 - Numbers 3-9 at the top of Tremont St. belong to Hotel Pelham, 185 belongs to Tremont St., according to the 1875 directory
 - On Carver St. the 52 between 54 and 56 has not been recorded, as it is a misprint.
 - Off of Boylston Sq. numbers 1-4 do belong to Boylston Sq., according to the 1875 directory.
- Map T
 - The unnamed street off of Buckingham St. is Burbank St., according the corresponding 1898 map. (Map 19)
- Map U
 - Spear Pl. has 5 written twice, there has been no evidence to show that either does not belong. Both numbers have been recorded.
 - Numbers 3, 4, 5, and 6 have been listed as part of Mahan Pl. due to the fact the Mahan Pl. intersects the numbers.
- Map V
 - The 3 at the top of Olive Pl. is out of order and a duplicate. It has not been recorded.
 - The 17 and 11 on either end of St. May Ct. are out of numerical order and are duplicates. They have not been recorded.
- Map W
 - Off of Trumbull St. there are numbers 1-4 which have not been recorded as it is unknown to where they belong to.
 - The 33 between 31 and 31.5 is a misprint and has not been recorded.
- Map X
 - Northampton St. has two 107's listed. The 107 closer to 101 could be 105 or 103, but there is no information to prove either one. It has been recorded as 107
 - On West Springfield St. there is a 66 and 68 listed among the 80's. They have been recorded as 86 and 88, as those numbers would fit the numbering sequence for that area.
- Map Y
 - On Shawmut Ave. two numbers have been cut off. Those have been recorded as 657 and 659 which would fit in the number sequence.

- Numbers 3-11 at the intersection of Warren Ave. and Columbus Sq. belong to Columbus Sq. according to Boston Streets: Also its Avenues, Courts, Places, etc.
- On West Concord St. there are two 158's. The 158 listed directly below 160 has not been recorded, as it is a misprint.
- Northampton St. there are two 224's. The 224 written below 222 has not been recorded, as it is a misprint.
- Tremont St. has two 957's listed on it. The 957 closer to 961 has been recorded as 959 to maintain numerical order.
